<b>A0</b>	I am unable to express myself.	I understand very little or nothing at all.	I recognise a few words.	I cannot write in the target language.
<b>A1</b>	I can interact in a simple way provided the other person is prepared to repeat or rephrase things at a slower rate of speech. I can ask and answer simple questions. I can use simple phrases and sentences to describe where I live and people I know.	I can recognise familiar words and very basic phrases concerning myself, my family and immediate surroundings when people speak slowly and clearly.	I can understand familiar names, words and very simple sentences, for example on notices and posters or in catalogues.	I can write a short, simple postcard, for sending holiday greetings. I can fill in forms with personal details, like my name, nationality and address. I use simple isolated phrases and sentences.
<b>A2</b>	I can communicate simple and routine tasks requiring a simple and direct exchange of information on familiar topics. I can handle very short social exchanges, but can't keep the conversation going myself. I can use a series of phrases and sentences to describe things in simple terms.	I can understand phrases and vocabulary related to very basic personal information, shopping, local geography, etc. I can catch the main point in short, simple messages and announcements.	I can read very short, simple texts. I can find specific, predictable information in simple everyday material such as advertisements, menus and timetables. I can understand short, simple personal letters.	I can write short, simple notes and messages. I can write a very simple personal letter, for example thanking someone for something. I use simple phrases and sentences linked with simple connectors like "and", "but", and "because".
<b>B1</b>	I can deal with most situations likely to arise whilst travelling in an area where the language is spoken. I can enter unprepared into conversation on topics that are familiar: family, hobbies, work, travel and current events... I can connect phrases in a simple way in order to describe experiences and events, my dreams, hopes & ambitions.	I can understand the main points of clear standard speech on familiar matters at work, school, leisure, etc. I can understand the main point of many radio or TV programs on current affairs or topics of personal or professional interest when the delivery is relatively slow and clear.	I can understand texts that consist mainly of high frequency, everyday, or job-related language. I can understand the description of events, feelings and wishes in personal letters.	I can write personal letters describing experiences and impressions. I can write connected text on topics which are familiar, or of personal interest.
